# **GUIDELINES FOR RARE BREEDS DOG SHOW**

To help you get the most from your participation in the All Star Dog Show feature area, please read the following information thoroughly.

#### RARE BREEDER BOOTHS ARE NOT RETAIL BOOTHS

Your booth in the Pet feature area is for the sole purpose of promoting your breed or kennel. Any other type of promotion; pet food manufacturer, obedience training schools, etc. are classified as retail activities and are contracted and invoiced accordingly.

## SHOW ENTRY

You will receive two Exhibitor badges per contract. Additional passes are available at a cost of \$6.00.

## HOURS

Please arrive early enough to be set up when the doors open to the public. Booths must be manned at all times. **SHOW HOURS** are 10:00A.M. to 8:00 P.M. weekdays; 10:00 A.M. to 8:00 P.M. Saturdays; and 10:00 A.M. to 6:00 P.M. Sundays. Please note that the terms of your agreement include staying until show closing.

## SALE OF PUPPIES

**No puppies may be delivered to buyers on the show premises.** You may negotiate the sale, but not the delivery. All pups attending must have had their shots. You are welcome to promote your own puppies, but not allowed to act as an agent for a second party. Please do not bring female dogs in heat, or pups that have not had their shots.

## SAFETY

Every dog you bring must have excellent temperament. Well-socialized dogs with proper restraints reduce the potential for problems. It is a long day for the dogs, and the potential for them to get a little irritable is present -- please be careful. Please ensure your dogs and puppies are properly inoculated, free of parasites, and clean.

#### DOG COMFORT

There will be an indoor 'doggie on the spot' convenient to the Breed Club area. Should any accidents occur in the aisles or booths, **please** clean up after your dog. Please use the shovel provided in the relief area to remove feces. There are thousands of people at the show -- we need your cooperation to keep it clean and pleasant smelling! Otherwise, it creates a poor image for all of us. With large crowds, temperatures rise, so you may wish to bring a cooler.

#### ALLERGIES

Please do not use any aerosol products in the area -- an allergic reaction can jeopardize someone's health. Your cooperation is requested.

# FINDING YOUR BOOTH

When you arrive into the pet area, register at the registration booth. On some days there may be duplication of breeds; please ensure that you are in the right booth. If you have any questions, please check the floor plan that will be posted at the registration booth or ask your coordinator.

## **BOOTH DECOR**

Each booth will have 8' back and 3' side drapes. You are welcome to bring photos, ribbons, trophies, business cards, signs naming your dogs and their titles, etc.
